





Evolution of farm labour force (persons) in the sector of agriculture (1990=100)




Farmers by age and replacement of farmers aged 50 year and + (2016)






Distribution of farms by size and by part in the walloon UAA (2018)

(Holdings with 5 cows and +)














Land usage – average 2016-2018

(in % of the value (in SO**) of total agricultural production of the municipality)





(in % of the value (in SO**) of total agricultural production of the municipality)









Share of area under organic production by type of crop (2018)










